

Two Regina marathoners from the Regina Road Runners Club, won their age group divisions at the grueling 3-day Tahoe Triple Marathon. The event circumnavigates Lake Tahoe, passing through California and Nevada, and runs from October 7 to 9. The athletes run one marathon (42.2 km) a day for 3 days in a row.

Jennifer Taylor won the women's 40-44 age group and was the 5th woman overall. Her overall time was 12 hours, 53 minutes and 27 seconds, with individual marathon times of 4:01:46, 4:03:28 and 4:48:13.

Milos Kostic won the men's 60-64 age group and was the 14th man overall. His marathon times were 3:55:50, 3:58:44 and 4:02:50, giving him an overall time of 11 hours, 57 minutes and 24 seconds.
