

International Tahoe Triple

Two Regina athletes won their respective age divisions at the international Tahoe Triple at Lake Tahoe finishing October 8. To complete the event, athletes run a marathon every day for three days in a row. Jennifer Taylor was the second woman overall and first in the women's 40-44 year age class, posting individual marathon times of 4 hours, 9 minutes and 22 seconds; 4:20:14; and 4:29:37 for a combined total of 12:59:13. Milos Kostic won the men's 60-64 age class with marathon times of 4:09:56; 4:19:42 and 4:23:15, giving him an overall time of 12:53:15. He was the 29th man. Both runners have now completed this demanding international event twice.

Bizz Johnson Trail marathon

Milos Kostic placed third in the Men's 60-69 year old age group at the Bizz Johnson Trail marathon in Susanville California. His time was 4 hours, 27 minutes and six seconds. This was Kostic's fourth marathon in four days after his first place age group finish in the Tahoe Triple ultramarathon.
