

Tahoe Triple, October 9, 10 & 11, 2003.

Three members of the Regina Road Runners club tripled the challenge of a marathon at the **Tahoe Triple**. At Lake Tahoe, Nevada, 74 runners from 4 countries tried to finish 3 marathons in 3 consecutive days, with the last race on Oct 11, 2003. Out of the 65 finishers, Milos Kostic of Regina placed 11th overall and 2nd in his age group of men, 60-64 years. His times were 3 hours, 59 minutes, 49 seconds, 3:58:34 and 4:29:29. Jennifer Taylor, also of Regina, was the 3rd woman overall and 2nd in her age group of women aged 40-44. Her marathon times were 4:13:59, 4:06:16 and 4:38:36. Gary O'Connor who was 36th overall and 3rd in the Clydesdale division. His times were 4:51:12, 5:10:46 and 5:15:31
